On motion of Mr. Swift Ordered —  
That when the Senate next adjourn, it ad-  
journ without day; and that a message be  
sent to the House of Representatives request-  
ing its concurrence. Which message was  
delivered by the Secretary.

A message was received from the House  
of Representatives concurring in the forego-  
ing proposition.

Mr. Woodbury, from the Committee  
of Conference on the part of the Senate on  
the disagreement of the two Houses on the "Re-  
solve in favor of certain Commissioned Officers  
of the Revolutionary War and the Widows of  
deceased Officers," reported that they had  
made diligent search for the Conferees on  
the part of the House and had been unable  
to find them — therefore recommended that the  
Senate adhere to the vote indefinitely postpon-  
ing said Resolve — read and accepted.

The Committee on Engrossed Bills reported  
as correctly engrossed.
