

Mr. Dudley: I would like to know about the well you were pumping from with an engine and sending up into the reservoir?

Witness: We pumped from it at that time 5 times. It then got so that it would not supply the pipe as rapidly as we liked to move it and so we shut off. I don't know how long it may hold out. Never have exhausted it to my knowledge.

Q. Are you now under orders to raise the dam? A. Yes sir. The stone is being moved on to raise what we call "Reservoir No. 2", 2 feet. That will increase the storage very much more indeed.

Another point is in regard to the laundry which was quite insufficient to meet the wants of such an institution as that, and it was not possible ~~that~~ ^{with} the appliances then ~~in~~ hand to do the laundry ^{work} in a good and sufficient manner.
