The two Houses met in Convention according to assignment to elect three Senators, one for the Second Senatorial District, and two for the tenth Senatorial District to fill the vacancies in said Districts.

Messrs Strickland and Soule of the Senate and Messrs Cornstocks of Lubec, Lyman of Portland and Paine of Sanford of the House were appointed a Committee to receive, sort, and count the votes for one Senator to fill the vacancy in the second Senatorial District.

Which Committee, having attended to the duties assigned them reported that the whole number of votes given in was 187.
