Voted that ^{Nathl} ~~both~~ Sparhawk Esq be & hereby he is desired to receive the Claims & enquire into & state the just Proportion of the several Rights of the Claimants to the Tract of Land holden under Samuel Phillips & William Phillips described in the Petition of the said Nathaniel Sparhawk Esq & others to the Hon. Samuel Danforth Esq dated the 28 July 1768 for the Warrant for calling this meeting; and that he be empowered to employ such Person or Persons as he shall judge most capable of assisting him in this Business

Voted that Nathaniel Sparhawk Esq be & he hereby is fully empowered to take Advice of any Person or Persons learned in the Law & upon such Advice, in Behalf of this Propriety, to bring Writs of Trespass & Ejectment against any Person or Persons who have trespassed or may hereafter trespass on Lands belonging to this Propriety described in the Petition of the said Sparhawk & others to Samuel Danforth Esq dated July 28 1768 for the calling of this meeting, & who have unlawfully entered or may hereafter unlawfully enter on the same or any part thereof

Voted that this meeting be adjourned till the first Day of February next, then to meet at this place
