

Bill to incorporate the Delphi Granite Company (introduced in the House,) read and referred to the Committee on Manufactures, in concurrence.

Bill to incorporate the Gardiner Shoe Manufacturing Company was read the second time, amended, and passed to be engrossed.
Sent down for concurrence. Concurred.

Bill to incorporate the Winslow Lock and Dam Company came up — The House, none renewing the Senate in the recommitment of the Bill, insisted on its vote indefinitely postponing the same. The Senate, insisting on the vote recommitting the same, propose a Conference, and appoint us Conferees, Messrs. Benson, Smith and Mildram. Sent down for concurrence. Concurred (and Messrs) Getchell of Waterville, Bradford of Sebec, and Pratt of New Vineyard were appointed Conferees on the part of the House.

The Joint Select Committee to which were referred sundry petitions in relation to license laws made a report — read and accepted, in concurrence.

Bill to regulate the sale of Brandy, Rum or any strong liquors (reported by said Committee) was read once, the amendments of the House adopted, and the said Bill was referred to the next Legislature, and ordered to be printed in all the public Newspapers of the State, in concurrence.
