

They understand that the change is necessary.

Q. All of them A. Yes sir, I think so.

Q. And are willing to pay \$7 a week for their friends in the lodge and scarcely any clothing A. They have never made any objection that I am aware.

Q. You are quite sure that they all have the notice A. I could not say certainly. I think they understand it. I have told them of it.

Q. Do you always notify them when you put a patient in unless you have a general understanding

A. There is a general understanding

Q. Do you notify them in every case that they are taken out and have to be put in for any length of time?

I don't mean for a day or so, but 3 weeks in the lodge and 3 weeks in the private room A. I don't notify in that case. There is an understanding.

By Mr. Hall:

Q. You never do that except there is an agreement and understanding A. An understanding,
