

Ordered, that the Secretary and Treasurer of State be authorized and directed, in printing the Act, entitled "an Act providing for the disposition and repayment of the Public money, apportioned to the State of Maine, on a deposit by the Government of the United States;" to cause the words "do with" in the 6th line of the 18th section thereof to be omitted—read and passed.

Mr. Swift, from the Joint Select Committee to which was referred the petition of Joseph Stockbridge and others, an order relative to altering the constitution in relation to the time of the annual election of State Officers and the time of the sitting of the Legislature, made a report submitting a Resolve entitled "Resolve to amend the constitution relative to the time of holding the annual State elections, and the sitting of the Legislature" which report was read and accepted.

Mr. Littlefield moved that said Resolve be referred to the next Legislature, and that the Secretary of State, in the mean time, cause the same to be published, in all the Newspapers, that publish the laws of the State, six weeks successively, the last publication to be six weeks before the annual election in September next.
