

Legislature on petition of William Vanes and  
others read and accepted. 387.

Sent down for concurrence. Concurred.

The Committee, consisting of the Delegation  
of the County of Lincoln, to which was referred  
"Bill additional to an Act to regulate the Jurisdic-  
tion and Proceedings of the Court of Probate,"  
made a report, recommending that said Bill  
be recommitted to the Committee on Division and  
Alteration of Counties, with instructions to report  
an order of notice to next Legislature on the  
several petitions upon which said Bill was  
founded read and accepted, in concurrence.

Bill authorizing the town of Bucksport to take  
Stock in the Penobscot River Rail Road Corpo-  
ration, came up from the House of Repre-  
sentatives indefinitely postponed. The Senate re-  
cede from the vote passing said Bill to be engrossed  
and <sup>indefinitely</sup> postponed the same, in concurrence.

Bill to incorporate the Philadelphia and Maine  
Granite Company, (reported in the House by  
the Committee on Manufactures, on petition  
of John Stewart and others);

to incorporate the Somerset Bridge, (reported by Mr.  
Swift from the Committee on Roads and Brid-  
ges, on petition of Russell Blackwell and others)

additional to incorporate the proprietors of Curri-  
tunk Bridge, (reported by same on petition Elijah  
Grever,) severally read once and tomorrow ten  
o'clock assigned for a second reading
