

with an Amendment from Art 10
reported which was read & accepted, and is as
follows -

At a legal Meeting of the Proprietors holding Lands
in the County of York under Bridget Phillips late
of Bolton deceased on the 21th day of September 1782

Whereas the said Proprietors together with
the Proprietors of Land in the same County under
the Title of Nicholas Shapsleigh have agreed to
submit the Limits of their severall Claims
to the Determination of Federick Pebble and others
a Committee appointed by the General Court
to enquire into the unappropriated Lands of the
State and the said Committee have reported that
a part of a Township called Shapsleighs Town laid
out and settled by the said Proprietors holding Lands
under Nicholas Shapsleigh hath fallen within the Claim
of this Propriety, and whereas Application hath been
made by Benjamin Chadburn and James Sullivan
Esq^r Agents to the said Shapsleigh Proprietors to
purchase the same for the consideration of Sixty
pounds which bargain and sale is recommended
by the said Committee - Therefore Voted that this
Propriety do give, grant and release to the said
Shapsleigh Proprietors being the persons named aforesaid
in the Report aforesaid all that part of the said
Shapsleighs Town which lies to the Northward of a
line drawn Northwest from the Northern corner
of Sandford Little Ospey River¹⁰ with the Privileges
and Appurtenances to them their Heirs and Assigns
forever - Provided Never the less if the said
Proprietors holding under Nicholas Shapsleigh shall
not within three Months from this Time lodge with
the Clerk of this Propriety sufficient security for the
Payment of the said Sixty pounds within one Year
from this Time - this Grant shall be null and void.
Voted that John Avery and Col. Josiah Waters be a
Committee to agree and settle wth the Honble Com^{rs}
Chadburne and James Sullivan Esq^r Agents
wth the Shapsleigh Propriety the boundaries of the Land
set off by the Phillips's Propriety to the said Shapsleighs
