Q. In your judgment does the position of superintendent require a man of great patience and kindness of disposition and deportment? A. I think that is a very important element and requirement at any rate in a man holding that position.

Q. Do you think Dr. Barlow possesses ~~that~~ requirement? A. I regard Dr. Barlow as a man that is patient. He is mild, not hasty or rash in coming to his conclusions. But when he does come to them he comes intelligently, understandingly, and is firm in his position if he believes it to be right.

Q. From your observation and acquaintance with him is he a man of great kindness of disposition? A. Very much so. I think that is a very prominent trait of character in the superintendent.

Q. Do you regard that as an exceedingly valuable trait in a superintendent? A. I do in that position.
