

My own strong impression is that father took this trip in the
centennial year, 1876, + that the old journey died the year
following. He d, 1875. (Dundee record)

Sebattis told how there was once a council at Seoddy where
the new party wanted to get some measures passed + their
delegates started off in advance of Kicatomis Branch +
Fourth Lake. The old party heard of it that night + started
a strong delegation to circle them by going up main stream
and carrying into upper Seoddy. There was a snow + they
pushed ahead of night, killed a moose + sat + got
in first, but they were so hurried against the new
party that they left them close pieces + threatened
+ killed where tie them into their canoes + set them
adrift at sea. Sebattis was one of the old party.

Marie Chagnon was the mother of Gen. Sebattis Mitchell.
She was old and blind when seen in 1887, an old, thin,
but fine-appearing woman.
