Attean, Attian, Atean = St. Etienne, Stephen.

Clossian n Gassian

Piel = Pierre, Peter.

Sibattis, Sobattis, = St. Baptiste n St. Sebastien?

Toma, Tomer = Thomas

Necola, Nicolai = Nicholas

Noel, fr. French Noel, n Noel (Noel being an old French form)

Tellis Arnes = ~~Phyllis Agnes(?)~~ <sup>Teresa Agnes</sup> ~~Anna~~

Eneas = Ignace

Lola = Logola - Laurence

Mitchel = Michel, Michael.

Orem = Uzzah, John. Maliseet ~~Uzarianis = same~~ Swasein = Joachim (Masta)

Dana, Drune, Druny = Dennis, Denny

Suep, the spoken, Isab the written form of Joseph

Uzzah, with mouth pen like a French nasal, & voice raised (Uzzah) = John. Have they any other name for John
