Resolve in favor of Cherryfield Academy (re-
ported with amendment by Mr. Greene, from the
Committee on Literature and Literary Institutions
to which said Resolve had been referred,) read
twice, and the question of passing the same to
be engrossed, as amended, was decided in
the affirmative, by yeas and nays, as follow
