

By them or their Assigns respectively settled and improved But the P. Thomas and his Associates shall keep and save them wholly indemnified therefrom and also that neither the Grantors nor their heirs shall by virtue of this Grant be bound or held to warrant the said Granted Premises to the P. Thomas nor to his Associates or Assigns Nevertheless in Law any Action or Suit shall be brought against the said Thomas his Associates or Assigns for the said Tract of Land or any part thereof the said Proprietors hereby promise and engage at their own cost and expence to defend the said Suit and put the same to final Judgment through the whole Course of the Law if there be Occasion provided the said Thomas his Associates and Assigns shall give the said Proprietors reasonable notice thereof

Then the meeting adjourned to Sunday the Sixth instant to meet at 7 o'clock P.M. at the same place

Tuesday August 6th the Proprietors met according to adjournment and further adjourned to Tuesday the 13th instant to meet at seven o'clock P.M. same place

Tuesday August 13th 1771 The Proprietors met according to adjournment. Present Mr Moderator, Mr Phillips D^r Warren Deacon Marsh Mr Brown & Mr Adams

Voted that Mr Thomas Parsons have the Liberty, agreeable to his Request, of pitching upon the Eightteen Lots in the Township granted to him & his Associates, instead of the twelve first Sellers, as is mentioned in the second Article of the Grant, entered the 29th of June last

Voted that Nathaniel Spashawk and David Sewal Esq^s be and hereby are empowered and directed to cause to be laid out all the Lands belonging to the Proprietors from the Northerly side of Chapee River, extending North to a parallel Line with Sundry Books

Voted that there be granted to three such Persons as both Spashawk and Mr Sewal shall judge proper, three hundred Acres of the Land to be laid out as aforesaid, to be equally divided between them: Upon Condition that such Grantees shall take the Care of the Remainder thereof on behalf of the Proprietors, and immediately take possession of their respective Grants, build each of them an house thereon of at least Eighteen feet square and live there for the Space of seven years and that within the said seven years they bring up on each of their respective Grants at least seven Acres fit for mowing and tillage
