A message was received from the House of Representatives that that Branch had not concurred the Senate in their proposed amendment to the Bill to incorporate the Augustus and New York Granite Company had amended said Bill by striking out the word "Five" in the last line of the Bill and inserting "One" in lieu thereof. The Senate recede from their vote ordering said Bill re-engrossed, adopt the amendment proposed by the House, and order said Bill re-engrossed as thus amended, in concurrence.
