Order from the House of Representatives, instructing the Committee on the Judiciary to inquire into the expediency of passing a law to limit the time for commencing criminal prosecutions and actions for penalties and fines—read and passed, in concurrence.

Order from the House of Representatives, instructing the Committee on the Judiciary to inquire into the expediency of repealing the first section of an Act additional to an Act regulating Divorce approved March 5, 1834—read and passed in concurrence.

Order from the House of Representatives, appointing Messrs. Ingalls of Denmark, Meads of Simmington, Freeman of Bridgeton, Spruce of Waldborough, Godfrey of Goldborough, Bradford of Sebec and Ide of Frankfort, a Committee with such as the Senate may join to inquire into the expediency of so altering the law, that private property of any or all of the Stockholders of any Corporation, here after incorporated by this State, shall be liable and holden for the debts of the Corporation—read and passed and Messrs. Robinson of Lincoln, Strickland and Soule are joined, in concurrence.
