 and seconded that an Agent be appointed to appear before
 the Committee appointed by the General Court to exhibit
 the claims of the Proprietors Lands holder under
 Bridget Phillips and to support the same and that
 Mr. Joseph Waters Junr. be and he hereby is appointed Agent
 for this Purpose -

Resolved to adjourn till the 28th day of August Next, Tuesday
 Evening, then to meet at the Court House in Boston
 at 6 o'clock P.M. and said meeting is adjourned
 accordingly -
