Henry M. Barlow, recalled

- Q. What year did you enter the service originally as assistant physician? A. In 1844
- Q. You continued as assistant until what year
- A. I commenced in Vermont asylum and then came to Maine.
- Q. I meant in this asylum? A. 1845.
- Q. You continued as assistant physician here until when? A. Feb. 1851
- Q. Then you became superintendent and have been so since? A. One year acting superintendent. Since then I have continued superintendent to the present time. When I first became superintendent the building could only accommodate about one hundred patients. The building then consisted of the centre building and two wings, the wings 90 feet each. Since then ~~the~~ 2 north wings and 2 south wings have been built, or one north and one south and 2 east. There are now accommodations for about 400
