Voted, that part of Lott N^o 10 be lotted and bounded as follows
viz. beginning at the E. N. corner of Lott N^o 86 and running south
easterly, partly on that Lott and partly on Lott N^o 85 being
187 rods, till it meets Lott N^o 24 then running south Westerly partly
on said Lott and partly on Lott N^o 126 till it strikes Lott N^o 30
being 172 rods and from thence running E. Westerly 187 rods,
thence E. Easterly 172 rods to the first mentioned bounds making
in the whole two hundred acres be & hereby is reserved for the
use of the Ministry and of a School forever to be under the
direction of the Selectmen for the time being. —

Voted, That a Committee be appointed to proceed on
the business respecting the Lands between the Chapees, to enter upon
the Land and as far as they may judge necessary, examine the
same - and make such enquiries and obtain such particulars, as
may tend to benefit the propriety, and to make report as soon as
may be, and that the Committee consist of three & any two of
them to be a quorum; and that M^r Martin Brimmer Esq^r
Josiah Waters and M^r John Wheelwright be and they are
hereby appointed for the above purpose —
