

On motion of M^r Maguire, the Senate reconsider their vote of yesterday, proposing to be engrossed. Bill giving power to the County Commissioners for the County of Cumberland to lay out a road over the tide waters from Brunswick to the Great Islands in Harpswell and the same was referred to Messrs. Maguire, Woodman and Robinson of Lincoln.

Bill altering the time of holding the Court of Common Pleas in the County of Cumberland (reported in the House by the Committee on the Judiciary on petition of Samuel Wells and others)

Resolution requiring the Cashiers of Banks to make returns of the names of Stockholders (introduced in the House)

in favor of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians (laid on the table by M^r Burr)

granting to each of the towns of Northport and Ellsworth, in the County of Waldo, the third volume of the laws of Maine (reported by Mr. Carr from the Joint Select Committee to which was referred the petitions of David Alden Jun^r) severally read once and to-morrow eleven o'clock assigned for a second reading.
