Wednesday June 3rd 1772 The prop^{rs} met according to Adjournment, and the
members of the prop^{ty} brought to the General Court informing them that there was
a petition exhibited to Court, praying for a Grant of a Township out of those
Lands belonging to the prop^{rs} which was referred to a Committee. It was the
desire of the prop^{rs} that those members would appear for them when needful
to defend their Title. The Clerk also desired to write to Mr Parsons and
Mr Sewall about the papers &c. Then the meeting was adjourned to Wednesday
the 17th instant to meet at the same place 6^o Clock P.M.

the same place at 7^o Clock P.M.

Wednesday Oct^r 7th the prop^{rs} met and further adjourned to Wednesday
the sixteenth day of January next then to meet at the same place 6^o Clock
P.M.

Jan^y 16 1773 The prop^{rs} met according to Adjournment and voted it as their
desire that the Clerk should write to David Sewall Esq^r to know what progress
had been made in their Affairs and what Situation they were in Also to desire
him to procure of Coll^l Sparhawk who is in an Ill State of Health, all the
papers in his possession relating to the prop^{rs} Lands & stating their Interest in
the same. Also to know of him if need be, whether he could attend at Con^{ts}
of the General Court, if one should be appointed to enquire into the prop^{rs}
Title, and what time would suit him for that purpose.

Then the meeting was adjourned the first Tuesday in Feb^r next to meet
at 6^o Clock P.M. the same place

Tuesday Feb^r 2nd 1773 The prop^{rs} met according to adjournment, and
further adjourned to the morrow evening 6^o Clock P.M. same place
